Participants will work with Bluestem Quarry and Stone Works of Lucas to re-build a stone wall that needs major repair. Mortar mixing, choosing stone, and laying up a failing wall will be facilitated during the workshop. The setting will be a historic farmstead with stone house and outbuildings still in use.

Friday evening a free social event in Wilson, KS, open to the public, will feature Preservation Architect **Julia Manglitz** of TreanorHL, Lawrence. She will talk about her work and show examples of projects she has worked on. The geology, culture and architecture of the Post rock limestone will be emphasized throughout the workshop.
